PROGRAM NOTES

Graduates are listed alphabetically under the degree they are receiving, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts. In some cases, a student may earn more than one bachelor's degree during his or her undergraduate years. The student's major(s) are listed to the right of his or her hometown, with a concentration indicated within parentheses. Directly below each name is the student's hometown. Titles of yearlong Senior Theses or Senior Creative Projects judged to merit recognition appear in italics underneath the hometown, along with the name and terminal degree of the faculty supervisor.

President's Medalists wear gold medals awarded in recognition of their status. Students graduating *summa cum laude*, *magna cum laude* and *cum laude* Latin honors wear gold, silver and red tassels respectively on their caps. Student members of Mortar Board, a national honor society that recognizes college seniors for their achievements in scholarship, leadership and service, also wear gold tassels on their caps.

Today's processions are selections chosen from *The Water Music* (1717), and *Music for the Royal Fireworks* (1749) by George Frideric Handel (1685-1759), and *Sinfonia in D* (1780) by Joseph Bologne (1745-1799). The recessional is a selection from *String Quartet No. 7, K. 160* (1773) by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. *Fanfare for the Class of 2023* is an original composition by Associate Professor of Music HyeKyung Lee, D.M.A. Musical selections are being performed by Kt Amrine '24,

violin; Sara Jarecke '25, violin; Wenyi Shi '24, violin; James Van Reeth, violin; Rainer Yaeger '24, violin; Charles Ziegert '23, violin; Duncan Jones '24, viola; Henry Kline '25, cello; Daniel Ziabicki '26, cello; Cameron Ziegenfus '24, cello; Larry Griffin, trumpet; Eli Lishack '26, trumpet; Doug Moran, trombone; Carolyn Redman, trombone; and Bradley Krak, tuba. The commencement orchestra is conducted by Assistant Professor of Music Philip Rudd, B.M.E., M.M., D.M.A.

Flowers for the program are provided by Village Flower Basket. The program concludes when the platform party and faculty have recessed. The audience and graduates are asked to remain seated during the recessional.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic costume which makes the Commencement procession so colorful is more than 800 years old, dating back to the days when students were members of the minor clergy and wore monkish gowns and hoods. Today, the hood is used only as an ornament. It is lined with the colors of the university conferring the degree: the border in which it is edged indicates the scholar's field. The colors seen in today's Denison procession and the fields they represent are: Dark Blue: Philosophy; White: Humanities; Golden Yellow: Science; Light Blue: Education; Brown: Fine Arts; Pink: Music; Silver Gray: Oratory (Speech); Scarlet: Theology; Lemon Yellow: Library Science; Sage Green: Physical Education; Drab: Commerce, Accountancy, Business.

RETIRING FACULTY

SOHRAB BEHDAD

B.S., MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY; M.A., MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY; PH.D., MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY
PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF ECONOMICS

Sohrab Behdad holds a B.S. in electrical engineering, followed by an M.A. in economics and a Ph.D. (1973) in economics from Michigan State University. Professor Behdad came to Denison in 1985 after a career at the University of Tehran in Iran, which he left when the Islamic State began its “cultural revolution” to Islamicize Iranian universities. While a member of the economics faculty at the University of Tehran, Sohrab co-founded the National Association of Iranian Professors and was chief editor (economics) of the Tehran Technological University Press.

As a political economist who approaches the teaching and scholarship of the discipline through historical and social contexts, Sohrab has revered Denison’s commitment to the liberal arts. In his years at Denison, he has taught Principles of Economics, Introduction to Microeconomics, International Finance, International Banking, Political Economy of Sanctions, Political Economy of the Middle East, and History of Economic Thought.

Throughout his nearly four decades at Denison, Sohrab’s contributions have been dedicated and widespread. He began and consequently directed the Global Studies

Seminars for 18 years through 2003, an initiative that continues to engage students and faculty alike. Notably, he was a co-founder of the university’s philosophy, politics, & economics and international studies programs, as well. Sohrab held the John E. Harris Chair in Economics from 2002 until 2017 and also has been involved with Middle East and North African studies at Denison.

Beyond his efforts on campus, Sohrab held the positions of executive secretary and president of the Middle East Economic Association between 1990 and 1995, and he has been a member of the editorial board of the International Journal of Middle East Studies. He was a founding member of the Board of Directors of the International Iranian Economic Association with involvement since 2012.

Closing the chapter on his time teaching, Sohrab reflects on a career that was intellectually rewarding and enjoyable to the extent that he was not in a rush for it to end. He feels fortunate to have pursued a profession that has been intellectually exciting and stimulating. He expects to continue his engagement in scholarship in the political economy of Iran and the Middle East in his retirement years.

LAURA BOYD

B.A., CARLETON COLLEGE; M.A., OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY; PH.D., OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY
ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF ECONOMICS

For Laura Boyd, a love of numbers was established in graduate school, where she arrived at labor economics as her specialty. The ability to look at data and test theories was rare within the field at the time, but a passion for analyzing investments in human capital through labor economics became the foundation of a dedicated career.

Professor Boyd's area of study analyzes the effects that investments in education have on labor market outcomes. Analyzing how investing in education specifically impacts an individual's future earnings became the basis for much of her research. Her dissertation analyzed default behavior, with federally subsidized student loans, in particular, using data about borrowers that wasn't as easily or commonly quantified. This work led her research exploration around economic "signaling," such as whether degree completion is a valued "signal" in the labor market. Most recently, Boyd analyzed the differing impact that earning a GED has for immigrants compared to U.S. natives and has also contributed data and empirical work to the theoretical research projects of others.

For her own educational experience, Laura attended Carleton College as an undergrad, where she enjoyed the relationships formed with both students and professors within a liberal arts setting. After completing her M.A. and a Ph.D. at Ohio State University, what brought Laura to teach at Denison in 1991 was the ability it provided to give back and make a difference for her students while continuing her research. Born and raised in Ohio, coming to the Granville campus was an opportune move for building both a teaching career and a family.

In her time within the Department of Economics, as well as with Denison's data analytics major, Laura has loved bringing students to share her own prevailing love of numbers. Her courses have empowered students to not only test economic theories quantitatively, but to find the human story in real-world data. Hearing from graduates about how both the skills and connections gained in her classroom have been valuable is an experience she will miss.

Laura was integral to the formation of Denison's data analytics major, knowing that her economics students, as well as other social science majors, could benefit from this more quantitatively focused area of study. She also had heard from former students working in analytical fields that the data analytics major, as designed, would be a perfect complement to the other skills within their liberal arts education. Established as a standalone B.A. degree, this pioneering approach became the prototype for similar programs across the country. In her last three years on campus, she has served as director and looks forward to the lasting impact that data analytics will have on Denison graduates from many disciplines.

In retirement, Laura looks forward to more freedom within her calendar, but also the possibility of finding new ways to get involved. She plans to spend time with family, enjoy the spontaneous pace of traveling and hiking, and eventually explore new settings in which she can contribute her analytical skills.

ERIC LIEBL

B.S., UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-MADISON; PH.D., UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, BERKELEY
PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF BIOLOGY

Eric Liebl joined Denison's Department of Biology in 1994. Attracted to Denison by the university's strong and clear commitment to supporting academic scholars, he has enjoyed teaching small classes and laboratories with engaged undergraduate students, while still pursuing his own meaningful research within a supportive intellectual environment.

Professor Liebl's interest in the molecular side of biology began in the early 1980s as interest in genetic engineering was building. This curiosity grew into an enduring passion through his undergraduate research at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. It later continued with graduate studies at the University of California, Berkeley, and postdoctoral research in the McArdle Laboratories back at Wisconsin. Throughout all his work, Eric has found a connecting thread in being able to experimentally manipulate molecules to ask relevant biological questions.

At Denison, Eric served as chair of the Department of Biology from 2002 to 2007. He has a substantial peer-

reviewed publication record and has had several grants from both the National Institutes of Health and the National Science Foundation to support his research with Denison students. Additionally, he has supported the university as a member of Denison's Institutional Review Board and as coordinator of the neuroscience concentration for several years.

Across his semesters of teaching, Eric has marveled at what his students have been able to accomplish in the classroom and laboratory, from making successful base-specific DNA edits with CRISPR in his genetics course to pushing pluri-potent embryonic cells to develop preferentially into cardiac muscle cells in his developmental biology course. He has greatly appreciated the financial and institutional support that has made it possible to pour his experience back into his undergraduate students, and he will fondly remember his laboratory "sandbox" in Denison's Samson Talbot Hall. In retirement, he looks forward to setting aside grading but will retain his love for teaching.

ANN TOWNSEND '85

B.A., DENISON UNIVERSITY; M.A., OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY; PH.D., OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY
PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF ENGLISH

Ann Townsend recalls being an avid reader from an early age, however, it was in her own undergraduate classes at Denison that she discovered a connection to poetry. After graduating in 1985, she went on to earn her M.A. and Ph.D. at Ohio State, pursuing a growing interest in the field. The opportunity to return to Granville in a teaching capacity came when one of her former creative writing professors retired from Denison in 1992.

As a member of the English and creative writing faculty at Denison, Professor Townsend has been recognized for her teaching, scholarship, and writing. She has held the Thomas B. Fordham Chair in Creative Writing and served as director of creative writing. Her course offerings have ranged from creative writing and 20th-century poetry and poetics to literary translation and the history of the lyric poem.

Ann has greatly enjoyed teaching classes that extend her field of expertise while helping students find a voice of their own. A favorite course from across her years of instruction was English/Environmental Studies 291, which she taught not only as a literary exploration of nature but also as an immersive experience that asked students to engage with the natural world both physically through fieldwork and creatively through various modes of writing.

Beyond academia, Ann Townsend is the author of three collections of poetry: *Dime Store Erotics* (1998), *The Coronary Garden* (2005), and *Dear Delinquent* (2019). She also is the editor of a collection of essays, *Radiant Lyre: Essays on Lyric Poetry* (2007), and her poetry and essays have appeared in many magazines. Townsend has been the recipient of grants from the National Endowment for the Arts and the Ohio Arts Council, and she also has received fellowships from the Bread Loaf Writers Conference, the MacDowell Colony, the Virginia Center for the Creative Arts, as well as the Bernheim Arboretum and the Lannan Foundation. Additionally, she is a co-founder of VIDA: Women in Literary Arts, which accepted the Barnes & Noble Writers for Writers Award in recognition of its work for the larger literary community in 2016.

Since retiring last December, Ann Townsend has transitioned to being a full-time writer, spending her days creating poetry, essays, and even a little fiction. She looks forward to completing her next collection of poems. Her post-academic life has also made time and space to work in collaboration with other artists and writers, travel with her husband, and continue with her passion for hybridizing modern daylilies at her farm in the Granville area.

DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS, HONORIS CAUSA

LORD MARK MALLOCH-BROWN
B.A., M.A., M.A.

Lord Mark Malloch-Brown has worked to advance human rights, justice, and development for more than four decades in a variety of roles: with the United Nations, the World Bank, and as a British government minister, as well as with a range of civil society groups and businesses. His distinguished career in international affairs includes service as deputy secretary general of the United Nations under Kofi Annan, heading the United Nations Development Programme, directing external affairs at the World Bank, and working as a British government minister.

Malloch-Brown served the British government as Minister of State for Africa and the United Nations at the Foreign and Commonwealth Office under Prime Minister Gordon Brown. He spearheaded the global promotion of the United Nations Millennium Development Goals as head of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) from 1999 to 2005 under then-U.N. Secretary-General Kofi Annan. At the UNDP and previously as head of external affairs at the World Bank, Malloch-Brown led reform efforts that were widely seen as increasing the impact of both organizations. He later served as Annan's chief of staff before his appointment as U.N. Deputy Secretary General.

Knighted for his contribution to international affairs, Malloch-Brown is currently on leave from the British House of Lords. As president of Open Society Foundations, the world's largest private funder of independent groups working for justice, democratic governance, and human rights, he oversees the foundation's work in more than 120 countries around the world.

"Global challenges require persistent and creative leadership," says Malloch-Brown. "Graduates from liberal arts institutions such as Denison can examine and disentangle systems to advocate for the kind of holistic solutions we need. I am looking forward to this opportunity to engage with future leaders."

A Distinguished Practitioner at Oxford University's Blavatnik School of Government, Malloch-Brown is an adjunct fellow at Chatham House's Queen Elizabeth Program and has been a visiting distinguished fellow at the Yale Center for the Study of Globalization. Malloch-Brown's spouse, Trish Cronan Malloch-Brown, is a member of the Denison Class of 1986. She has recently completed her term as a member of the Denison Board of Trustees and is now a trustee fellow. Two of their children attended Denison.
